Paul Marston has won more than 50 national open titles at bridge and his books have sold more than 500,000 copies.

He has taught more than 10,000 people to play bridge and his lessons are still in demand. His beginners' course in Double Bay in February 2020 sold out with 138 people, all coming from word of mouth - there was no advertising at all.

The course fee was \$149 and more than 70% opted to continue until coronavirus got in the way.

This is the same course that is now being offered online for free.



Nevena Djurovic has developed the website and written the tutorials. She has won 8 national women's titles at bridge and she has a strong background in software.

After completing a Masters of Electrical Engineering, she developed software for robotics. Then she worked on a power station simulator and an air traffic control system before spending 7 years as the software development manager of Ozemail, one of this country's leading Internet Service Providers. Then she became the director of information technology at Warner Music, a division of Warner Bros.
